

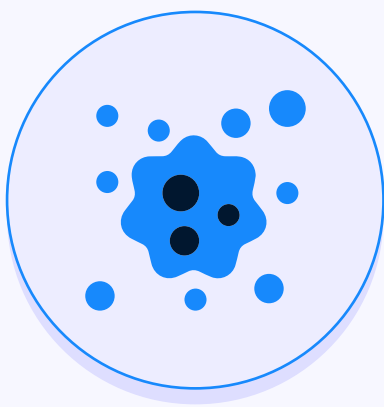


Why Does My

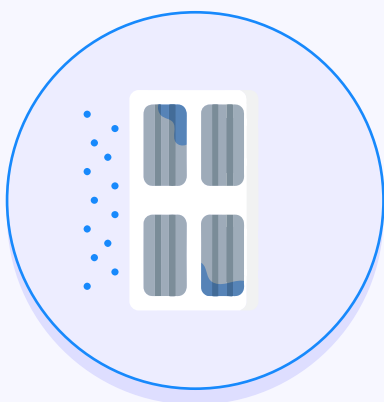


Mold and Mildew Buildup
