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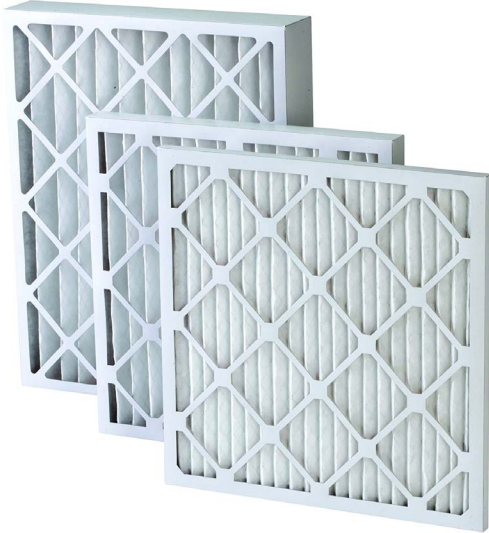
Maintaining Your HVAC System Between Appointments

Replace Air Filters

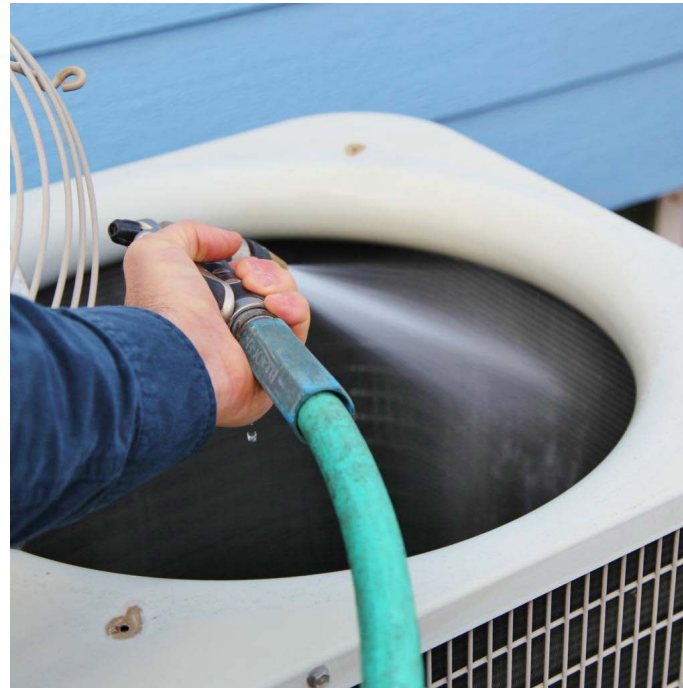


Air filter inspection and replacement are some of the easiest tasks to accomplish without professional help. It is still part of routine maintenance and recommendable to leave it to experts if you have a complicated HVAC system. However, most units come with a simple user manual for air filter replacement. The air filter traps dust, dirt and other contaminants from your air, improving the air quality and preventing potential damages that could occur if these particulates reach delicate components of the unit. However, this buildup of dirt may render the filter ineffective, calling for timely replacements. If you live in a dusty surrounding, have pets, or more people visiting your home, you should consider replacing your air filters more frequently.

Clean Your System And Surrounding Area

Replacing your air filters can help keep the system in optimal performance. However, if the unit is dirty and surrounded by all kinds of dirt, leaves, debris, pets, and mold, it will have a hard time running at maximum efficiency. It is recommendable to keep your air conditioning and heating systems free of dust, sticks, pollen and other debris. You can wipe the top and sides using a glove or hose if necessary. Remove anything that blocks the airflow to avoid straining your system. It is also vital to clean your registers and remove any debris from your ducts. However, comprehensive duct cleaning is best left to experienced professionals. Your duty is to eliminate general dirt and debris, blocking airflow and affecting the unit's performance.

Give Your System A Break



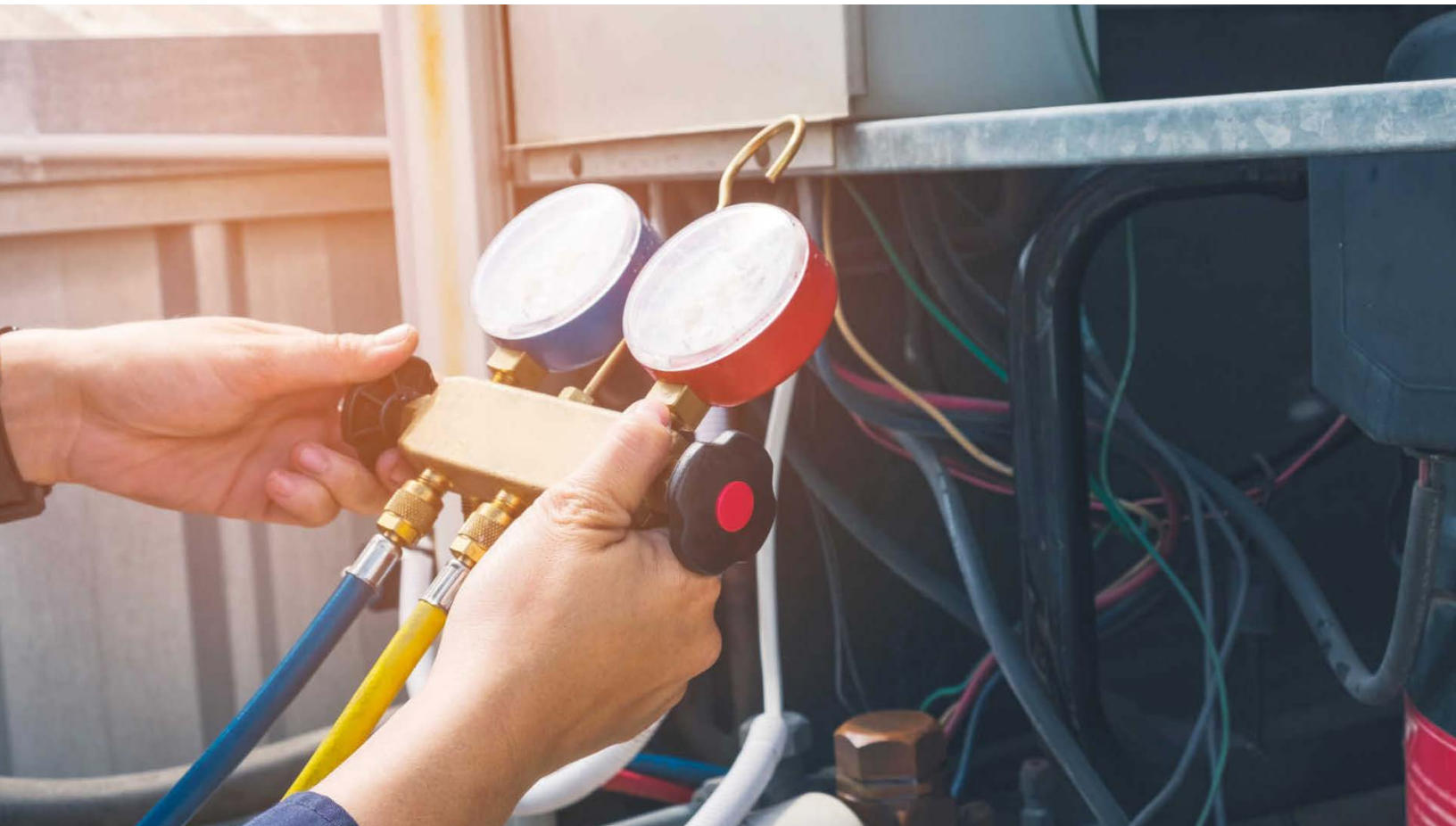
Allowing your system to rest is one of the best ways to extend its longevity. While HVAC units are designed to keep you comfortable across all seasons, using your system all-year-round will result in faster degradation in addition to soaring energy bills. You can avoid this by giving your system a break during periods you do not need them. For instance, you can use ceiling fans and other pedestal and tower fans to ventilate your rooms during cooler days. Drapes, insulated windows and thermostat programming can reduce the number of hours your AC and heating system runs. You can also turn off the humidifier water supply and replace the water panel during summer to give it a rest before turning it back on upon setting the right humidity levels.

Look For The Usual Symptoms Of Inefficiency

Regardless of what you do, HVAC units are made of mechanical and electrical components susceptible to breakdowns and natural degradation. As the user, it is essential to watch out for any signs of an issue. This can be anything from peculiar noises to dropping hot water temperatures or increased dust levels. It is recommendable to establish a regular HVAC self-inspection weekly schedule to look for any defects in the system.
